## Ritchie Elementary 2019-2020 Supply Lists



### Kindergarten

- 12 #2 pencils
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 3 boxes crayons, normal size (8 in each box)
- 6 large glue sticks
- 4 black Dry Erase Markers (fine-point, thin)
- Scissors with rounded tips (FISKARS are easiest for KG)
- Pencil box, no zipper (for crayons, pencils, scissors, glue)
- Paint Smock (old adult t-shirt works well)
- Bath-sized towel for rest time (no sleeping bags)
- Backpack (regular sized, without wheels)
- Extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks - in a zippered plastic bag)

### First Grade

- 24 #2 pencils, sharpened
- 3 boxes crayons (each 24-count)
- 1 box colored pencils (12-count)
- 1 box washable markers (8- count, generic work well)
- 6 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors (may use scissors from last year)
- 1 school box w/zippered pouch; may use last year's; (fabric preferred since plastic tears easily.)
- Paint Smock (old adult t-shirt works best)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol)
- 1 box freezer bags (gallon size)
- 1 box freezer bags (quart size)

### Second Grade

- 12 #2 pencils (prefer Ticonderoga brand, sharpened)
- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors (you may use last year's)
- 1 small school box or pencil pouch
- 2 composition notebooks (marble cover)
- 2 spiral notebooks (one-subject, wide-ruled)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol brand)



### Third Grade

- 24 #2 pencils
- 1 box crayons (24-count)
- 1 box Crayola markers (thin or thick)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 pair scissors (we suggest 7" student scissors)
- 1 zippered fabric pencil pouch (3-hole punched)
- 2 Composition notebooks (100 pages in each)
- 1 sturdy 2" 3-ring binder (NO Trapper Keepers!)
- 1 sturdy 1" 3-ring binder
- Write & Erase Colored Dividers (1 pkg of 8)
- 1 pair of inexpensive headphones / earbuds
- 1 box Ziploc-style bags (sandwich or snack)



### Fourth Grade

- 24 #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 box of markers (THIN, multi-colored)
- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- 1 box of colored pencils (8 or 12 count), sharpened
- 4 large glue sticks
- 2 highlighters
- 1 zippered fabric pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
- 2 Composition notebooks (100 pages in each)
- 1 plastic or poly pocket folder (label "HOMEWORK")
- 1 pair of scissors (label w/name with permanent marker)
- 1 pack of notebook paper (wide-ruled, loose-leaf)
- 1 pack 3 x 5 index cards
- 1 box gallon-size &/or 1 box quart-size baggies



### Fifth Grade

- 24 #2 pencils
- 1 box colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 box markers (10 count, basic colors)
- 1 box crayons (24 count)
- 2 packs dry erase markers (4 count in each)
- 6 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 highlighters
- 1 supply binder (cloth, zippered, i.e. Trapper Keeper)
- 1 pencil case or pouch (to be kept in Trapper Keeper)
- 3 packets of notebook paper (wide-ruled, loose leaf)
- 2 3-ring binders (hard-covered, 1-inch, w/ clear plastic pocket on front cover)
- 3 folders, with pockets (no brads)
- 1 pencil sharpener (handheld)
