## C. Hunter Ritchie Elementary 2023-2024 Supply Lists

**\*\*Required for ALL GRADES:** inexpensive corded headphones for Chromebooks

- 1 box quart freezer bags (no sliders please)

### ◆◆◆ Kindergarten

- 12 #2 pencils
- 2 yellow highlighter
- 4 boxes crayons (not jumbo) 24 in box
- 8 large glue sticks
- 1 container Baby Wipes
- 12 black Dry Erase Markers (fine-point, thin)
- Scissors with rounded tips (FISKARS are easiest for KG)
- Pencil box (hard plastic for crayons, pencils, scissors)
- Paint smock (an old adult t-shirt works well)
- Bath-sized towel for rest time (no sleeping bags)
- Backpack (regular sized, **without** wheels)
- Extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks, in a zippered plastic bag: Please label bag with student name)

### ◆◆◆ First Grade

- 2 boxes 24 #2 pencils, sharpened
- 3 boxes crayons (each 24-count)
- 1 box washable markers (8- count, generic work well)
- 6 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors (may use scissors from last year)
- 1 pencil box (big enough for pencils, scissors, glue, etc)
- Paint Smock (old adult t-shirt works best)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol)
- 1 or 2 jars of Play-Doh
- One 12pk fine tip black Expo Markers
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 box tissues

### ◆◆◆ Second Grade

- 24 #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 2 box of crayons (24-count)
- 1 box colored pencils (12-count)
- 8 large glue sticks
- 12 black dry erase markers-bullet tip
- 1 pair of scissors (you may use last year's)
- 1 3-hole zippered pencil pouch (no boxes please)
- 3 composition notebooks (marble cover)
- 2 box tissues
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes

### ◆◆◆ Third Grade

- 1 pair scissors (we suggest 7" student scissors)
- 1 zippered fabric pencil pouch (3-hole punched)
- 3 Composition notebooks, wide ruled (100 pgs.)
- 1 sturdy 1/2" 3-ring clearview binder
- 1 box crayons (24ct)
- 24 Pre-sharpened #2 pencils (not mechanical)
- 1 box Crayola markers (thin and/or thick)
- 6 large glue sticks
- 1 box skinny black dry erase markers (4pk)
- Donations welcome: glue sticks, dry erase markers, tissues, clorox wipes, Ziploc bags

### ◆◆◆ Fourth Grade

- 24 #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 2 highlighters
- 1 zippered fabric pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
- 2 Composition notebook (100 pages)
- 1" hard cover binder w/pockets (prefer clear view)
- 1 pair of scissors (label w/name with permanent marker)
- 2 pack of notebook paper (wide-ruled, loose-leaf)
- 1 hand-held sharpener
- 2 black Sharpie Markers
- 1 pack black thin dry erase markers (4pk)
- Donations welcome: tissues
- Gifted Classes: 1" binder w/ pockets, One plastic 3- hole 2pocket folder, 2pks wide loose leaf paper

### ◆◆◆ Fifth Grade

- 12 #2 pencils (per quarter)
- 1 box colored pencils (12 count)

- 1 box markers (10 count, basic colors)
- 1 box crayons (24 count)
- 2 packs dry erase markers (4 count in each)
- 6 large glue sticks (per quarter)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 highlighters
- 1 binder for supplies (cloth, zippered, i.e "Trapper Keeper)
- 1 pencil case or pouch (to be kept in "Trapper Keeper)
- 1 folder w/pockets 3-hole punch, no brads
- 1 pencil sharpener (handheld-no battery)
- 2 hard-covered, 1-inch, 3 ring binders with clear plastic pocket on front cover
- 2 packs of loose leaf paper
- 1 pack 3 x 5 index cards
- Ziploc bags (last name A-L: quart, H-Z: gallon)
- Donations welcome: wipes, tissues, pencil top erasers
- Gifted Classes: 1" binder w/ pockets, one plastic 3-hole 2pocket folder, 2pks wide loose leaf paper, composition notebook
