## 2024-2025 SCHOOL SUPPLIES LIST

### KINDERGARTEN

- 12 #2 pencils, *sharpened*
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 4 boxes of crayons (normal size) 24 in each box
- 12 large glue sticks
- 1 package of Baby Wipes
- 12 black Dry Erase Markers (fine-point, thin)
- Scissors with rounded tips (FISKARS are easiest for KG)
- Pencil box (hard plastic for crayons, pencils, scissors)
- Paint smock (an old adult t-shirt works well)
- Bath-sized towel for rest time (no sleeping bags)
- Backpack (regular sized, **without** wheels)
- Extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks, in a zippered plastic bag: Please *label* bag with student name)

**\*\*Please ONLY LABEL the Pencil Box, Paint Smock, Towel, Backpack & Extra Clothes with Student's name\*\***

### FIRST GRADE

- 4 boxes of crayons (each box 24-count)
- 2 box of #2 pencils (sharpened- total 48)
- 1 box of 8 washable large markers
- 6 large glue sticks
- 2-12ct boxes of fine tip black dry erase markers
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 pencil box (big enough for pencils, scissors, glue, etc.)
- 1 pair of scissors (may use scissors from last year)
- Paint Smock (old adult t-shirt works best-*labeled w/name*)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 jar of Play-Doh
- 1 box of quart sized bags (no sliders please)
- 1 package of baby wipes

### SECOND GRADE

- 24 #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 2 boxes of crayons (24-count)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 8 black dry erase markers-bullet tip
- 1 pair of scissors (you may use last year's)
- 1 pack of 10 pencil-top erasers
- 1 3-hole zippered pencil pouch (no boxes please)
- 2 composition notebooks (100 pages Marble cover)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 box of quart freezer bags (no sliders please)

### THIRD GRADE

- 24 #2 pencils, *sharpened* (not mechanical)
- 1 box of 10 ct. washable markers (thin and/or thick)
- 6 large glue sticks
- 4 thin black dry erase markers

### FOURTH GRADE

- 12 #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 or 24 ct.)
- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 highlighter
- 1 zippered fabric pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
- 1 wide-ruled Composition notebook (100 pages)
- 1" hard cover binder w/pockets (prefer clear view)
- 1 pair of scissors (label w/name with permanent marker)
- 1 hand-held sharpener (no battery)
- 2 black thin permanent Markers
- 4 thin black dry erase markers
- Donations welcome: tissues, paper towels, pink erasers, pencil-top erasers

### FIFTH GRADE

- 12 #2 pencils (per quarter)
- 1 box of markers (10 count, basic colors)
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 box of crayons (24 count)
- 8 black dry erase markers-bullet tip (per semester)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 6 large glue sticks (per quarter)
- 2 highlighters
- 1 pocket folder for homework
- 1 fabric pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
